

Non -Designated Properties Historic Plaque Program

Heritage-Patrimoine Cornwall (HPC) has initiated a Historic Plaque Program to recognize buildings that have historic and heritage significance in our community.

Owners of these properties can apply to HPC to have a plaque fixed to their building. We will give priority to buildings that are a part of the Historic Square Mile, the boundaries being Marlborough St to the east, Cumberland to the west, Ninth St to the north and Water St to the south.

The eligibility criteria are as follows:

- 1) The building owner will complete the Historic Plaque Application Form and provide as much information as possible such as date of Construction, Heritage Architectural style and features, name of owners and builder, significant uses of building (commercial or residential).
- 2) Occurrence of event or activity of historic significance at the property.
- 3) Ownership or occupation by a group or individual of local historic significance.
- 4) HPC will provide additional information they have access to.
- 5) HPC will develop wording for the plaque.
- 6) HPC will arrange for the design and purchase of the plaque.
- 7) Location for the placement of the plaque to be agreed upon by HPC and the owner, making sure the plaque is clearly visible from the street.
- 8) Maintenance of plaque is the responsibility of the owner.
- 9) The owner will agree that the plaque will remain on the building if the property is sold.

We are hoping the Historic Plaque Program will give owners of Heritage/Historical places a sense of pride in acknowledging that our city has a rich, important past that should be recognized and celebrated.



Cost of the plaque is \$264.95 (subject to change) plus HST and HPC will contribute 25% of the total cost.

The plaque is 8" x 10", black with bronze lettering.
